Dr. Turki obtained his medical degree from Emory University School of Medicine in Atlanta Georgia. He completed his orthopaedic residency at the University of Texas at San Antonio. Fellowship training in hand and upper extremity surgery is currently being completed at the University of Chicago. Sports Medicine On-Call

The fall sports season will be here soon and that means Sports Medicine On-Call kicks into high gear to be there when your student athletes need us.

Dr. Hartzog and Dr. Walcott, both Board certified and Fellowship Trained Sports Medicine physicians work together with trainers and physical therapists to provide the most comprehensive sports medicine program in central Alabama.

Sports Medicine On-call provides:

- 24 hour on-call coverage for sports injuries
- Friday night Jackson Hospital emergency room coverage for sports injuries
- Sports Medicine clinic each Saturday morning during football season. Clinics start at 7:30a at Alabama Orthopaedic Specialists 4294 Lomac Street in Montgomery. **Students need to arrive at 7:30a.** X-ray and MRI are available
- Rehab clinic for quick return to play
- Comprehensive physical therapy following an injury
- CPR instruction and taping clinics
- Coverage: over 40 schools in the tri-county area
