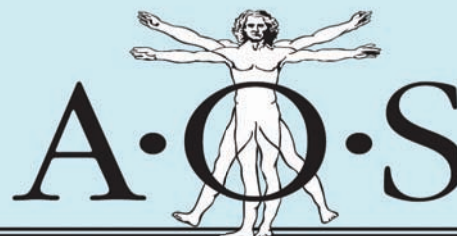

Fall Sports Season Just Around the Corner

The fall 2010 sports season is just around the corner and that means sports medicine kicks into high gear. Dr. Hartzog and Dr. Walcott, our board certified and fellowship trained sports medicine physicians provide sports medicine on-call coverage. Along with the Jackson Hospital Sports Medicine On-Call program, Dr. Hartzog and Dr. Walcott provide sports medicine coverage for over 30 schools in the central Alabama area.



Saturday sports medicine clinics begin this year on Saturday August 28th and run each Saturday morning of the high school football season. The clinics are held at our main campus in Montgomery starting at 7:30am. If you have a student athlete who is injured from a Friday night game consider our Saturday sports medicine clinic. All athletes under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Most major insurances are accepted.
